November 30 Hearing on Holiday Harbor Parking Area Request

A Public Hearing on a petition to use the open land (four lots) between the Holiday Harbor Marina and the nearby subdivision as a Sunset Grill parking area will be held at 5:33 PM on November 30, 2017 at the Escambia County Office Building in downtown Pensacola (221 Palafox Place). The specific request of item 13246 on the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners November 30 Regular Meeting Agenda is for "consideration of the vacation of a portion of the Gulf Beach (aka Holiday Harbor) plat. as petitioned by Thomas Bizzell, president of Holiday Harbor Marina, Inc." The agenda document further states that the 48 space parking area will include a "20-foot landscaped buffer on the north and east sides of the parking area, and a new stormwater area for the treatment of stormwater runoff on the developed area." Those interested in the outcome of this request should plan to attend the meeting and inform the Commissioners of their views on the petition.
