Perdido Key Issues

The National Park Service (NPS) hosted an Open House at the Perdido Key Visitors Center on June 28, 2016 and briefed those attending on alternatives for improving visitor safety and wildlife habitat at the Perdido Key Area of the Gulf Islands National Seashore (Johnson Beach). A significant problem has been visitors parking on the roadside but then crossing dunes and the habitat of protected species such as the Perdido Key beach mouse and various nesting birds.

The NPS preferred alternative would replace roadside parking with three new parking areas with upgraded dune crossovers; repave the road and add a second entrance lane; add parking areas and dune crossovers to the main parking area; restrict access on the last half mile to pedestrian and bicycle traffic; and, continue to allow primitive camping beginning half mile beyond the road terminus. At its June 16, 2016 Public Hearing, the Escambia Board of County Commissioners denied the "Petition to Vacate a Portion of the Siguenza Cove Plat, a subdivision recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 12, as petitioned by Perdido Key Oyster Bar, Restaurant & Marina, LLC, and GilbreathPetz Development, LLC."

"The Petitioners" intent was to "use the lots as overflow parking to keep customers from parking in the right-of-way of the public

streets." A substantial number of area residents attended the hearing with many opposed to the petition.

June 8 is recognized by the United Nations as World Oceans Day and a time to celebrate the importance of the oceans and consider action to reduce pollution and other activities affecting their wellbeing. The event was commemorated locally with a beach cleanup and barbecue cosponsored by Perdido Key State Park and the Friends of Pensacola State Parks.
