## **Perdido Key in District 1**

At its December 2, 2021 meeting, the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners voted 4 to 1 in favor of a redistricting plan moving Perdido Key from District 2 to District 1, effective immediately. There were seven speakers arguing against moving Perdido Key to District 1, but to no avail. District 1 Commissioner Jeff Bergosh is expected to hold community meetings in the near future to listen to area resident and owner hopes and concerns for the future. Your Perdido Key Association will continue working to keep our island a great place to live and visit and will keep you informed of redistricting and related issues as they emerge.

#### **Multi-Use Path West Portion Completed**

Construction has been completed on the Perdido Key Multi-Use Path from the west end of Perdido Key State Park to the Alabama border – about two miles. Design and engineering for the remaining approximately four-mile east portion from the west end of the State Park to the Theo Baars Bridge/River Road is completed with construction expected to begin at some point in 2022. The path has been fully funded as a

pedestrian and bicycle path, not for motorized vehicles such as golf carts or ATVs. As the path enters use in the months and years ahead, action to ensure its use by only pedestrians and bicycles will be a continuing challenge.

## **PKA Administrator Sarah De Lazzer Departing**

It is with sadness that we say farewell to Ms. Sarah De Lazzer, PKA's Administrator for the past eight years. Sarah has been an essential part of PKA's organization playing the major role in membership maintenance, communication, finance and multiple other areas. A real estate broker and full-time condominium manager, she nonetheless remained with PKA through the difficult condominium reconstruction period following Hurricane Sally. Sarah will be greatly missed and we wish her the very best in the future.

#### January 7 Gulf Power Presentation at Hub Stacey's

The Perdido Key Area Chamber of Commerce's Friday, January 7, 2022 Breakfast Brief at Hub Stacey's on Innerarity Point will feature Rick Byers, the Gulf Power Community and Economic Development Manager. This should be a good opportunity to find out more about recent installation of concrete utility poles on Perdido Key Drive and River Road, the possibility of underground utilities in the future, and Florida Power and Light's (FPL) recent rate increase proposal (Gulf Power becomes FPL on January 1, 2022), among other issues. The networking coffee begins at 7:30 AM with the presentation starting at 8:00 AM; pre-registration with the Chamber is recommended.

## **January 8 Shred Day at Gulf State Park**

Be sure to take advantage of "E-Cycling and Shred Day" from 8 AM until Noon on Saturday, January 8, 2022 at Gulf State Park Pavilion. The free event sponsored by Coastal Alabama Business Chamber and other local organizations will "securely and safely dispose of your personal documents or electronic items [but no batteries] without even having to exit your vehicle." 50 pounds of shred items are allowed; small paper clips need not be removed but please do not tape or tie bags or boxes.

## **Water Salinity Report**

Annual rainfall in our area in recent years has exceeded its normal 60 inches, with 2021 accumulating greater than 88 inches. Excess fresh water can lower salinity in local estuaries and other waterways and endanger biological systems such as sea grass and scallops. Lower salinity can be aggravated as development paves over natural areas that absorb rainfall and increases runoff. After years of delay the James Webb Space Telescope was launched on Christmas Day 2021, but that may have been the easy part of getting the complex instrument operational. During January 2022 multiple complex operations such as unfolding the telescope's heat shield and 21 foot mirror from their launch positions must be completed without a hitch so the instrument can explore the most ancient light of the universe.
